1. CHANGES TO THIS NOTICE

This Notice may be changed, modified, supplemented, or updated at any time. While we will endeavor to notify you of any changes to our Notice through our Website or direct communications as may be authorized by you, we encourage you to periodically review this page for the latest information on our privacy practices.

2. NO SALE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We do not sell your Personal Information and have not sold your Personal Information to any third party.

3. INFORMATION WE MAY COLLECT AND DISCLOSE ABOUT YOU

We may access, collect, process, store, use, share and be responsible for some or all of the following personal information that identifies, relates to, describes, is reasonably capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular consumer or household ("Personal Information"):

B. Internet or similar network or application activity.	Browsing history, search history, information on a consumer's interaction with our Website, application, or advertisement, and cookies.
C. Information that you may voluntarily provide to us.	Any other Personal Information that you may voluntarily provide to us (for example, in an email to our customer service)

This Personal Information is required to provide products and services to you. If you do not provide Personal Information we ask for, it may delay or prevent us from providing products or services to you.

4. HOW YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION IS COLLECTED

We collect the majority of your Personal Information directly from you through our Website and, under certain circumstances, via email, a form on our Website or by telephone. With respect to visitors to our offices, we may collect Personal Information from you in person as well as by telephone, text, or email. We may also collect your Personal Information directly from a third-party, including with your consent, as required and appropriate.

5. PURPOSES OF COLLECTION

Personal Information is collected for the following purposes:

- To provide and/or maintain our products or services;
- To provide you with information, products or services that you request from us;
- To allow you to participate in interactive features of our Website and any related applications when you choose to do so;
- To provide you with notices about your account and/or subscription, including expiration and renewal notices, email instructions, etc.;
- To fulfill or meet any other reason for which the information is provided;
- To provide you with email alerts, text message and other notices concerning our products or services or news that may be of interest to you;
- To provide customer support;
- For testing, research, analysis, development and improvement of product and service offerings;
- To improve our Website and present its contents to you;
- To monitor the usage of our Website or related applications;
- To host, store and otherwise process information needed for business continuity and disaster recovery.
- To carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, and to protect us, our employees, clients, and the public against theft, legal liability, fraud, or abuse;
- To detect, prevent and address technical issues;
- As necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property or safety of us, our clients or others, including system and network administration and security, infrastructure monitoring, identity and credential management, verification and authentication, and access control; monitoring and other controls needed to safeguard the security and integrity of transactions and/or recordation of information;
- To respond to law enforcement requests, subpoenas, including to law enforcement agencies and courts in the United States and as required by applicable law, court order, or governmental regulations;
- As described to you when collecting your Personal Information; and
- To evaluate or conduct a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of our assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which Personal Information held by us is among the assets transferred.

We will not collect additional categories of Personal Information or use the Personal Information we collected for materially different, unrelated, or incompatible purposes without providing you notice.

6. SHARING YOUR INFORMATION

We may disclose or share some, or all, of the Personal Information we collect about you to third parties such as service providers who aid us in processing and protecting your Personal Information to host the Website or related applications, send email or other communications, generate leads, process payments, provide analytics and advertising services, or moderate online discussions. When a customer buys a product or a service from us, we may share names, or other contact information that is necessary for the third party to provide products or services in the United States, Canada, and other jurisdictions. Our service providers are given Personal Information they need to perform their designated functions, and we do not authorize them to use or disclose Personal Information for any other purposes.

We may disclose or share your information if required to do so by law or in the good-faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on us, (b) protect and defend our rights or property or our customers or users, or (c) under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of our users, customers, or the general public. We may disclose or share your information to fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.

We may aggregate data we acquire about our customers. If we aggregate such data and provide it to external parties, our customers' Personal Information will not be attached to or included in such aggregated data. Also, in the event that all or a portion of our assets are acquired by or merged with a third-party entity, we reserve the right, in any of these circumstances, to transfer or assign the information that we have collected from you, including Personal Information and user data, in connection with such merger, acquisition, sale, or other change of control.

7. COOKIES AND OTHER TECHNOLOGIES

Cookies are small text files placed on your device to store data that can be recalled by a web server in the domain that placed the cookie. We may use cookies, web beacons, and other tracking technologies (such as scripts and tags) within our online services in order for them to function properly, make them more secure, provide a better user experience, to understand how our website performs, and to analyze how our services are used so we can continually improve.

As with most online services, our services leverage a combination of first-party (operated by Scinomix) and third-party (operated by external partners) cookies. - Provide services to you as contracted for by you;
- Show that we treated you fairly; or
- Keep records required by law.

We will not retain your Personal Information for longer than necessary for the purposes set out in this Notice. Different retention periods apply for different types of Personal Information. When it is no longer necessary to retain your Personal Information, we will delete or anonymize it.

11. KEEPING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION SECURE

We have implemented reasonable technical, physical, and administrative security measures to prevent Personal Information from being accidentally lost, used, or accessed in an unauthorized way. These measures offer appropriate, reasonable security levels, taking into account the state of the technology, the implementation costs and also the nature, the scale, the context and the processing purposes. We limit access to your Personal Information to those who have a genuine business need to access it. Those processing your information will do so only in an authorized manner and are subject to a duty of confidentiality. The measures are also intended to prevent unnecessary collection and further processing of Personal Information. The Personal Information is contained behind secured networks and is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems, and are required to keep the information confidential. We will notify you and any applicable regulator of a confirmed data security breach where we are legally required to do so.
